

**Board Meeting  
June 6, 2019**

The Colbert County Board of Education met on June 6, 2019 at the office of the Superintendent. The time of the meeting was 6:30 p.m. All members were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and a moment of silence held.

Upon a motion by Member Burgess and a second by Member James, the agenda was approved.

Upon a motion by Member Burgess and a second by Member Yarber, the minutes of the May 13, 2019 Board Meeting were approved.

During the Superintendent's Report, Superintendent Satchel reported on events and achievements within the school system.

Superintendent Satchel recommended the approval of Student Mobility Requests. Member Burgess moved that the recommendation be approved. Member Yarber seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Superintendent Satchel recommended the approval to declare non-working microscopes at Cherokee High School surplus and to dispose of them. Member Burgess moved that the recommendation be approved. Member Yarber seconded the motion and the motion carried.
