- Colbert County School District is accepting online pre-registration applications for the 2019-2020 school year beginning January 15th, 2019. These schools include; Cherokee Elementary, Colbert Heights Elementary, Hatton Elementary, Leighton Elementary, and New Bethel Elementary.
- Enrollment is open to all children 4 years of age on or before 9/1/2019 who are residents of the state of Alabama.
- Enrollees must provide the following documentation:
 - Birth Certificate, Proof of Residence, Social Security Card, Immunization Record
- Documentation must be brought to the school on or before the date of onsite registration.
- Public school system pre K programs have zoning requirements that determine eligibility to attend a program at a particular school. (Please contact Colbert County Board of Education for more information)
- No child will be denied participation on basis of income, sex, race, color, national origin, or disability.
